November 22 was the final Acoustic Night for the year - there is no meeting in December.

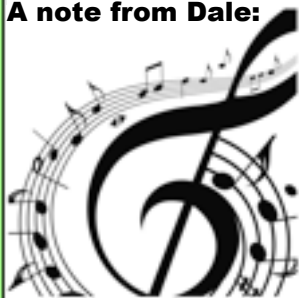
No main club night in January but Acoustic Night will on at the end of January. We'll send you a reminder!
