Blackboard:

In order to give as many performers as possible a slot on the blackboard, each performer slot will perform one item only of no longer than 5 minutes duration.

A recognised performing duo or trio is entitled to two songs with a change in the lead singer.

A solo act who invites a backing person up with them would not be deemed a duo and would only do one item.

A blackboard artist cannot be the lead performer on more than one blackboard slot even if accompanied by a different artist.

Individual performers cannot put their names on both the main and reserve lists.

Acts cannot pre-book a blackboard slot (with the exception of helpers).

A reserved Committee slot may be held open for any special performer who is approved by the Chair/Committee Member.

In the event of an unfilled blackboard the compere/committee will choose performer/s to do another item.

Acts on the reserve list cannot be guaranteed and will be asked to perform only if time permits.

Blackboard acts may not use their own sound systems, effects pedals or pre recorded music.

A floor person and/or sound man will help acts to set up for their performance.

A bass amp will be regularly set up by the sound crew; a Yamaha keyboard is available if requested prior to Friday setup.

The Committee reserves the right to amend the blackboard list to meet any circumstances they deem to be appropriate and beneficial for the Club.
