September Concert Night: Vic Manuel and Ruby Mae Solly





Our Concert Night guest artists for Friday 14 September 7.30pm are Vic Manuel, singer/ songwriter and Ruby Mae Solly, cellist, from Wellington. Vic's eclectic songs and guitar accompanied by stunning cello will be an intriguing evening. They have been described as "songs of the human condition, tongue-in-cheek, humorous and sad".

Born in 1953 in England of Irish parents, Vic and his family moved to Australia where Vic played flugelhorn in the school band and taught himself guitar. He started writing his own songs at age 16 and toured the east coast of Australia and Tasmania for many years, moving to America in 1999 where he played with guitarist Eric Schoenberg. Vic has recorded 5 albums and various EPs, and is frequently found entertaining in Wellington and participating in community projects.

Performing with Vic is Ruby Mae Solly. Ruby is a Ngai Tahu musician and writer who was the first person to graduate from the New Zealand School of Music with a degree in jazz cello. She has featured as a cellist on many recordings and has performed live with Whirimako Black, the Wellington International Ukulele Orchestra, the Troubles and the Frontliners. Ruby currently plays both cello and double bass in a range of Wellington ensembles whilst completing a masters in music therapy. This will be a memorable concert.

Annual Subs




