## February 2019 Concert Night with The Frank Burkitt Band

Over the last 3 years the band have released their debut album Fools & Kings in 2015, which reached No.12 in the Official NZ Music Charts. They have embarked on several national tours and have played several festivals across NZ. Inspired by artists such as Pokey Lafarge, Van Morrison, Billy Joel and The Wood Brothers, they play high energy, original music written by Frank and arranged by the band. They are releasing their 2nd album "Raconteur" at Port Fairy Folk Festival before embarking on a tour of Australia and New Zealand in March and April 2018.
