

Born 65 years ago in the Eketahuna Maternity Hospital. Allowed to freely grow up in a small-town New Zealand way: rugby at the domain, swimming at the river, treasure-hunting at the dump. At school, Gilbert and Sullivan, at home, Barry Crump. Shearing gangs, possum trapping, country roads and country pubs.

Palmy. First guitar, long hair and lectures. A short, shortsand-walk-socks High School career. Amateur dramatics and Hawera Folk Club. Auckland via the first Tahora

A musical apprenticeship in the folk clubs, cafes and markets of Auckland 1978 - 1984: Cook Street Market, Poles Apart Folk Club and street music in Parnell Village and K. Road.

1983/4 while touring with Taranaki Sol was offered the chance to record 'Time On The Road' L.P. for City Folk Records, both inspiring the path since followed: hitch-hiking and busking Highways One to Ninety-One taking solo shows of homegrown songs to the centres and edges of Godzone land.Along the way: further recordings, including: 'From the Edge' (Folk Record of the Year 1987), 'One For You', 'Songs Of Local Folk' and 'From The Tracks' cassettes for Replay Radio; at Rowan Studios, 'Home Is Where The Heart Is' (with Cath Woodman) and 'Shaky Isles'; with Gumboot Tango, the 'Taranaki Top Ten' and 'Rattle Yer Dags' cassettes and 'Rubber Sole' CD; the 'Past To The Present' and 'Here We Have A Land' CDs, compiling much of the above with newly recorded tracks. In 1992 'When The Pakeha sings Of Home – a Source Guide to the Folk and Popular Songs of New Zealand' for Godwit Press. Several series of programmes for National Radio 1989 - 1997 In recent years Mike has found home and family in New Plymouth along with a return to his original career, this time teaching young people to find music and their muse through guitar and song. Wherever there is a will to hear our own stories and songs there will be a place for this seasoned performer, both as a soloist or with good-time Kiwi-music band Gumboot Tango.
